



LOCKER AGREEMENT

1. All students intending to have the use of a school locker must acknowledge by signing this agreement that they understand and are willing to comply with its terms.
2. Lockers are owned and issued by the school. Students have no right or expectation of privacy in the locker insofar as a right or expectation of privacy pertains to the school.
3. Valuable items (money, electronic devices, watches, jewelry, etc.) should not be kept in lockers. **The school is not responsible for any items lost or stolen from lockers.**
4. Lockers are to be maintained in a neat and clean fashion both inside and out. No labels or stickers are allowed in or on the lockers at any time. The following are also not allowed in lockers: aerosol items, objects or pictures depicting alcohol or tobacco substances, or pornographic literature.
5. Unnecessary damage, vandalism, writing, etc. on lockers are prohibited. Students will be required to pay for the damage.
6. Students should keep their combinations confidential at all times.
7. Administrators reserve the right to reassign students to another locker as the need arises.
8. Combinations may only be changed once a school year for a fee of \$10.00.
9. A student may lose the right to use a school locker if any of the rules are violated.
